



INTRODUCTION GENERAL DESCRIPTION


The LOBO post puller attachment will remove a fence post or guardrail from the ground in one step, making it a one person job. This machine will pull round fence posts and also many shapes and sizes including T-posts and I-Beam guardrails. Take time to review and familiarize yourself with this Owner's Manual paying special attention to the safety and the operation sections.

1. Post Clamp Jaws

- a. Post clamp jaw assemblies are adjustable to pull post sizes 1" thru 8" in diameter.
- b. Virtually any shape, round, square, T-posts, H post, can be clamped and pulled.
- c. Able to grip and pull wood or steel posts.
- d. Clamp jaws are made from hardened steel, and will pull many posts before requiring replacement parts.
- e. Jaws are easily replaced. No tools required.
- 2. Post puller is quickly and easily connected to a skid steer, or other similar machinery. Mechanical and hydraulic hookup are quick and easy for any skid steer.
- 3. Post is loaded into the puller from the front, (as opposed to loading the machine over the top of the post). Posts can be removed and replaced while leaving an existing fence intact.
- 4. Post puller rests on the ground, requiring no lifting of post/concrete until post is completely broken free from the ground.
- 5. Machine is designed for minimum depth so it takes up less "Lane Space" when working on Highway jobs.
- 6. Post can be removed by one person.
- 7. Breakout pulling force of 27,000 lbs.





HYDRAULIC SAFETY

- Always place hydraulic controls in neutral before dismounting your loader.
- 2. Make sure that all components in the hydraulic system are kept in good condition and are clean.
- FLUID INJECTION HAZARD!
 DO NOT hold hand or finger over hydraulic fleak.
 Hydraulic fluid under high pressure will be injected through skin.
 Failure to comply could result in death or serious injury.
- 3. Replace any worn, cut, abraded, flattened, or crimped hoses and fittings.
- 4. Place hydraulic controls in neutral, and wait for all moving parts to stop before servicing, adjusting, repairing or unplugging. Cycle machine completely to the unclamped/down position before attempting servicing.
- 5. Do not attempt any makeshift repairs of the hydraulic lines, fittings or hoses by use of tape, clamps or cement. The hydraulic system operates under extreme high-pressure. Such repairs may fail suddenly and create a hazardous and unsafe condition.
- 6. Before applying pressure to the system, make sure all components are tight and that lines, hoses, and quick couplings are properly connected.
- 7. Wear proper hand and eye protection when searching for a hydraulic leak. Use a piece of wood or cardboard as a backstop instead of hands to find a leak. Hydraulic fluid escaping under pressure can have sufficient force to penetrate skin and cause serious injury, and if fluid is injected into the skin it must be surgically removed within a few hours by a doctor familiar with this form of injury or gangrene may result.

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SAFETY **OPERATING SAFETY**

- 1. Read and understand the Owner's manual and all safety decals before connecting, disconnecting, or adjusting or operating this machine.
- 2. Do not allow riders on this attachment during operation or transport.

Remember, YOU are the key to safety. good safety practices not only protect you but also the people around you from injury or death.


- 3. Keep hand, feet, hair, and clothing away from all moving and clamping parts.
- 4. Place hydraulic and skid steer controls in neutral, and wait for all moving parts to stop before servicing, adjusting, repairing or unplugging. Cycle machine completely to the unclamped/down position before attempting servicing.
- 5. Use caution when stepping over hydraulic hoses on entering and exiting machine.
- 6. When operating this machine, insure that you are at least 25 ft. from the nearest bystander, especially children.
- 7. When releasing a post from the gripping jaws, be careful. The post-concrete will fall to the ground which could result in injury to bystanders.
- 8. Stay away from overhead obstructions and power lines during setup and operation. Electrocution can occur even without direct contact.
- 9. Insure that Post Push Bar is installed prior to pulling a post or ay object that could fall into the cab. The post push bar also can be used as a hand hold for safer entry and exit from the loader.
- 10. Review all safety instructions annually.
- 11. Do not attempt to remove any type of telephone/utility poles with this machine. Due to the height and weight of thises type of poles, it may cause an unstable and unsafe conditions for the operators or bystanders.

FOR USE WITH A ROUND OR SQUARE POST




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1. IMPORTANT:

Follow all hydraulic and machine safety procedures listed above in the Operating and Safety section of your LOBO owners manual.

- 2. Unhook hydraulic hoses attached to the left hand cylinder. Place hydraulic hoses in the hose storage brackets.
- 3. Remove brace weldment from storage bracket located on the bottom of the unit.
- Unscrew nuts on the left hand cylinder plate. Remove the cylinder plate and attach it to the storage bracket located on the bottom of the unit.
- 5. Align the brace weldment and reattach nuts.




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SAFETY DECALS AND DECAL LOCATION


The types of decals and locations on the equipment are shown in the illustration below. Good Safety requires that you familiarize yourself with the various Safety Decals, the type of warning and the area, or particular function related to that area. If Safety Decals have been damaged, removed, become illegible or parts replaced without decals, new decals must be applied. - 1. Keep safety decals and signs clean and legible at all times.
- 2. Replace safety decals and signs that are missing or have become illegible.



HYDRAULIC LEAK DECAL 84769-2



OPERATION

The method of operation is as follows:

Hookup - Please read your skid steer owners manual. The hookup procedure is the same as other powered attachments for your skid steer loader.

 Drive up to the post, aligning post gripping jaw and V-clamp with the post.



The machine base must set on the ground to develop the required breakout force.

- Activate the hydraulic auxiliary circuit. The post will be clamped and pulled from the ground in one easy operation.
- Once broken loose from the ground, the puller and the post can be raised out of the hole by lifting the loader arms and carried to a desired location.
- 5. Post may be carried to the "drop" location, and released by activating the hydraulics to cause reverse flow, thus unclamping the post.

IMPORTANT: Make sure the area is clear when unclamping the post. A falling post may cause injury or death to a bystander or may cause unnecessary damage to other equipment.

SERVICE AND MAINTENANCE



Place hydraulic controls in neutral, and wait for all moving parts to stop before servicing, adjusting, repairing or unplugging. Cycle machine completely to the unclamped/down position before attempting servicing. Hydraulic fluid escaping under pressure can have sufficient force to penetrate skin and

cause serious injury, and if fluid is injected into the skin it must be surgically removed within a few hours by a doctor familiar with this form of injury or gangrene may result.

Metal burrs located on the cam clamps may inflict injury. Wear proper hand and eye protection when changing cam clamps or maintaining the unit.

LUBRICATION: Periodically remove pins and pivot bolts and apply a heavy grease such as Moly-Graph high pressure grease or equivalent to all points. This is especially important on the clamp jaws.

HYDRAULICS: Replace hoses that are showing wear. Replacement hydraulic hoses are available from Ammbusher, Inc. When changing hoses, make sure all components are tight and that lines, hoses, and quick couplings are properly connected before applying pressure to the system.

- IMPORTANT: Follow all hydraulic and machine safety procedures listed above in the Operating and Safety section of your LOBO owners manual.
- Remove Cylinder Plate from storage bracket located on the bottom of the unit.
- Unscrew nuts and remove the Brace Weldment. Attach it to the storage bracket located on the bottom of the unit.
- 4. Align the Cylinder Plate and reattach nuts.
- Attach the hydraulic hoses.
- Unpin and remove the SHORT THROW cam clamp on the right hand cylinder plate and attach the LONG THROW cam clamp.

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
